Free feeding is widely used and recommended for Puppies. If free feeding is not your desired feeding choice, below is a set of suggestions.

Dog Weight (lbs.)	Daily Feeding Amount (cups)
3	$\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{3}{8}$
5	$\frac{3}{8}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$
10	$\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{3}{4}$
20	1 - 1 $\frac{1}{8}$
30	1 $\frac{1}{4}$ - 1 $\frac{2}{3}$
40	1 $\frac{3}{4}$ - 2 $\frac{1}{8}$
50	2 $\frac{1}{8}$ - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$
60	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ - 2 $\frac{7}{8}$
70	3 - 3 $\frac{3}{4}$
80	3 $\frac{3}{4}$ - 4 $\frac{1}{2}$
Over 80	Add $\frac{1}{2}$ cup for each additional 15 lbs. of body weight.
